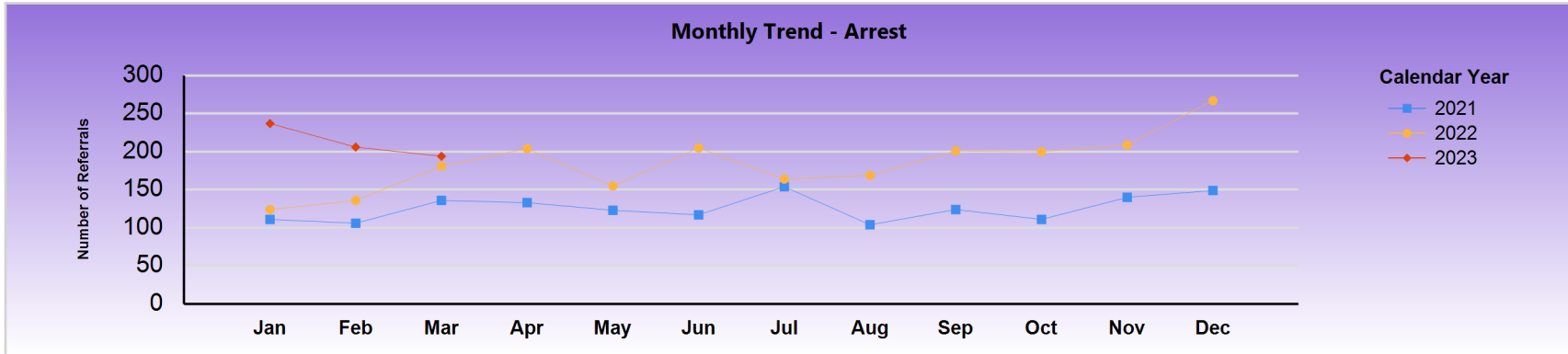




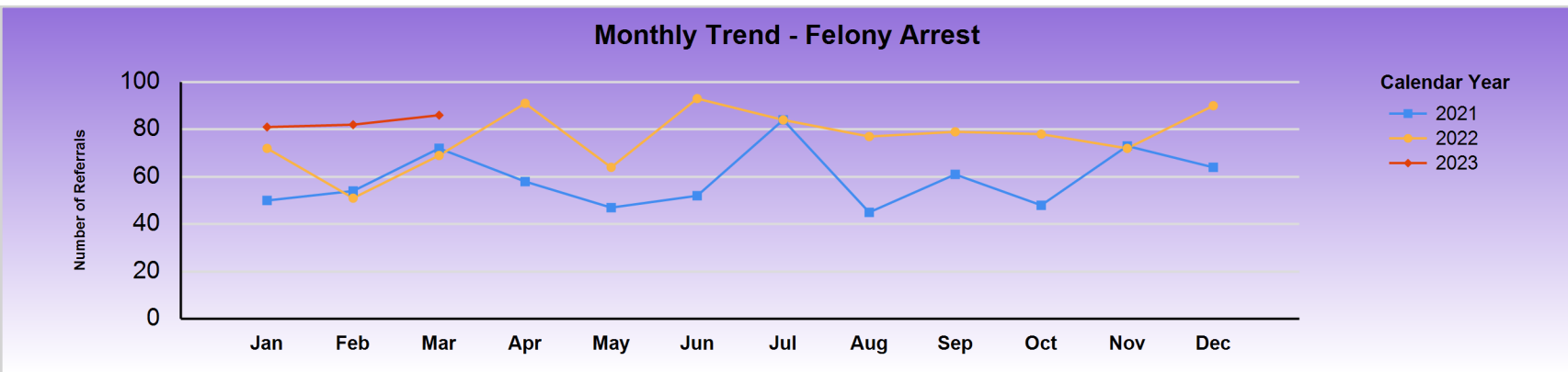

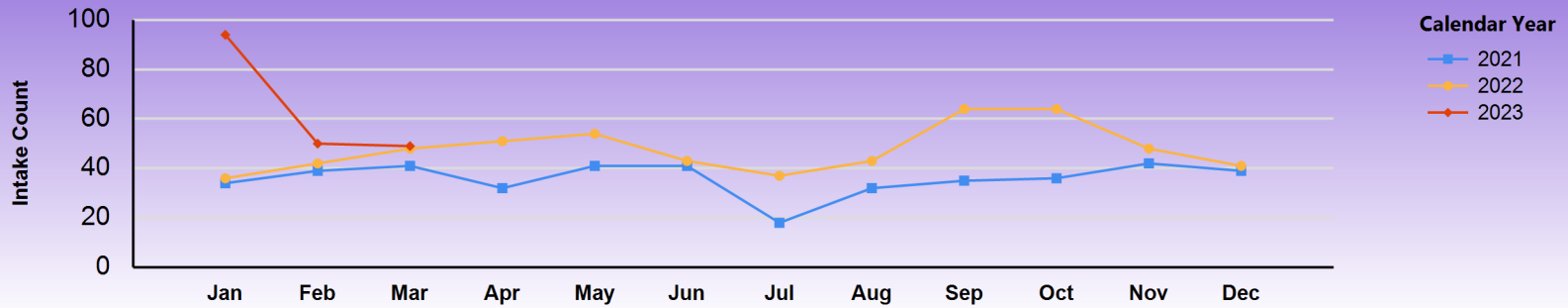

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Monthly Trend - Juvenile Hall Intake



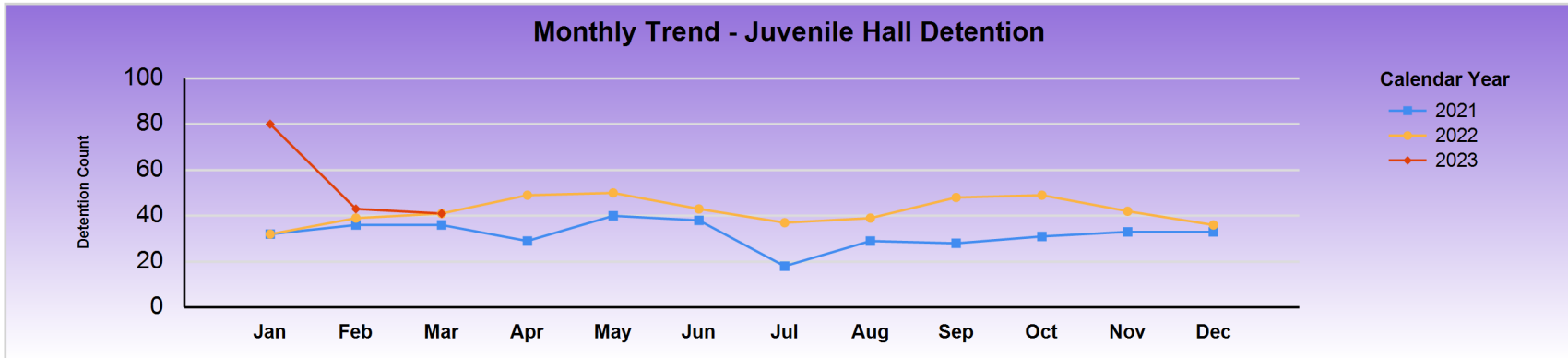

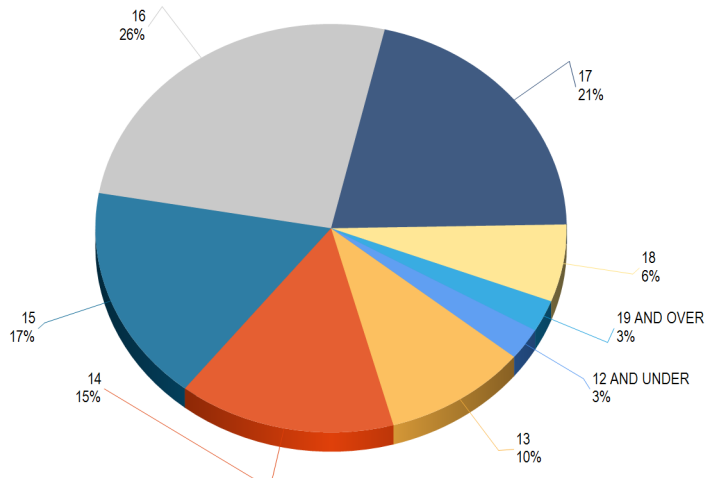
By Ethnicity (%)



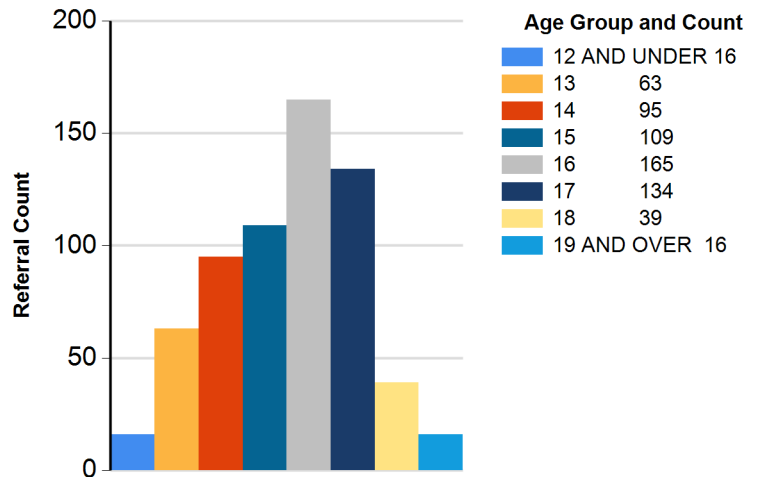
By Ethnicity (Count)

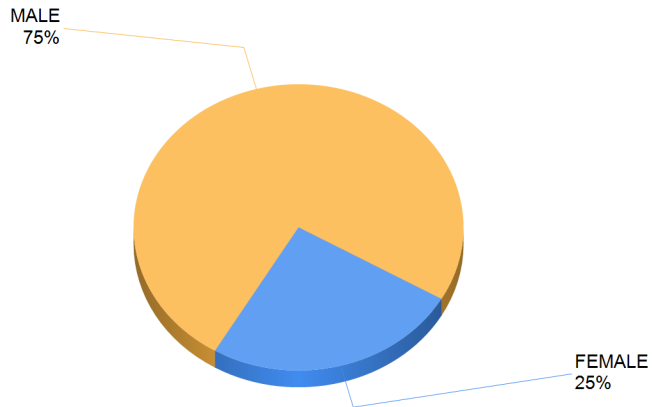

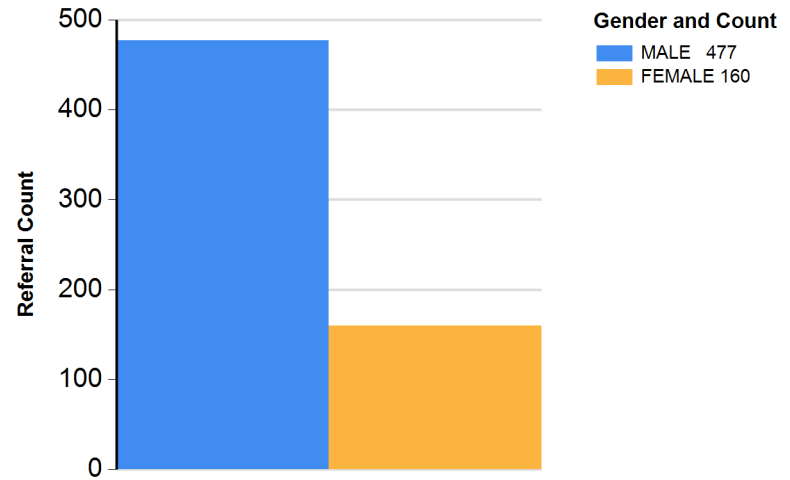

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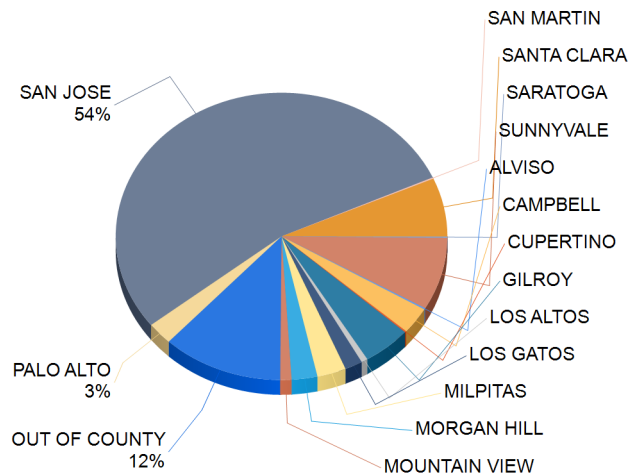
By Gender (%)



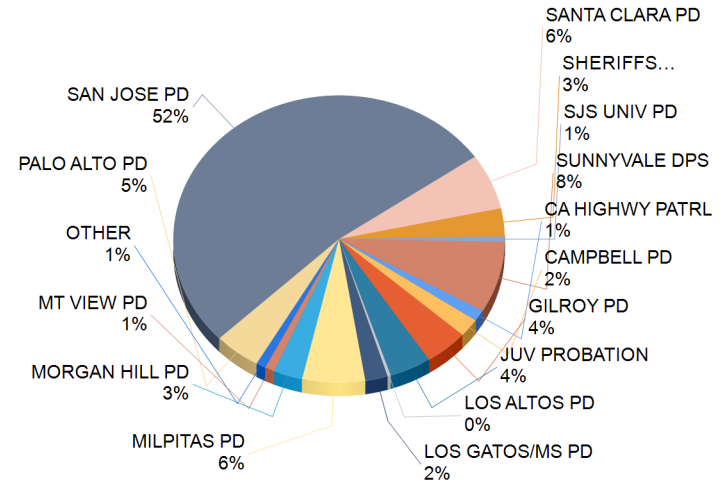

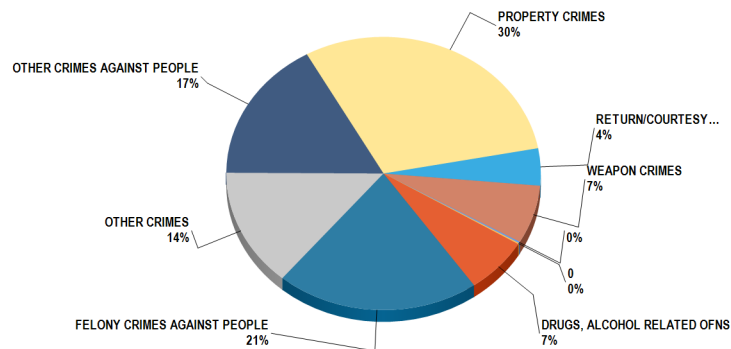
By Referral Type (%)



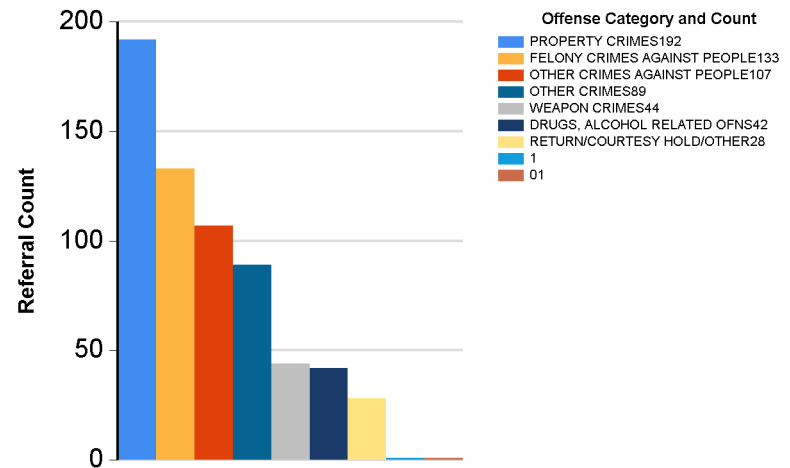
By Referral Type (Count)

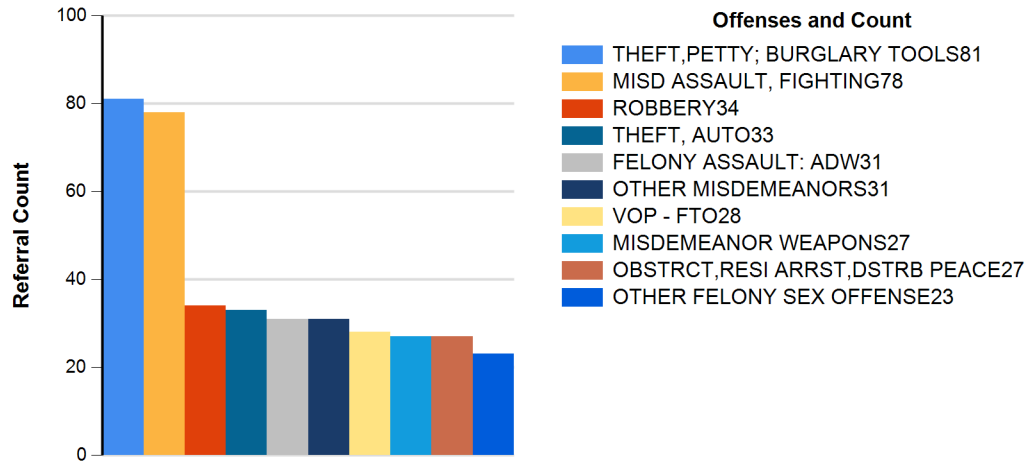

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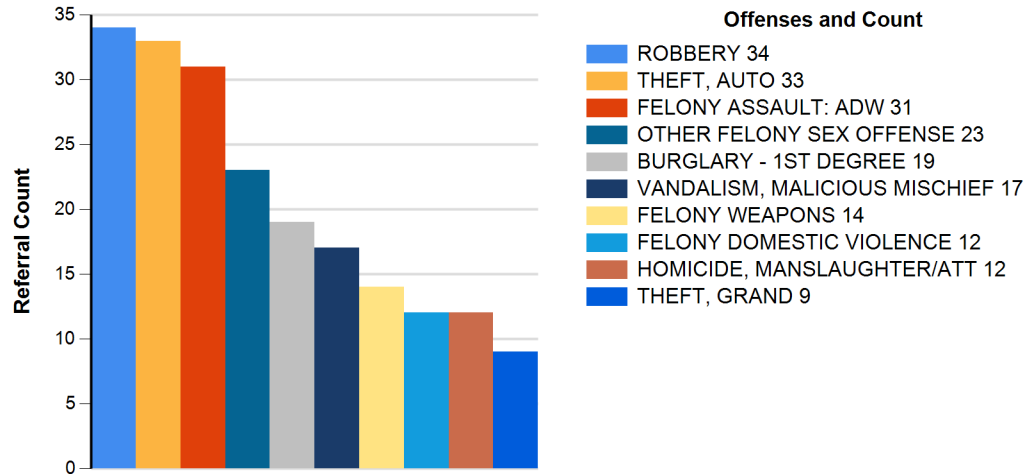
