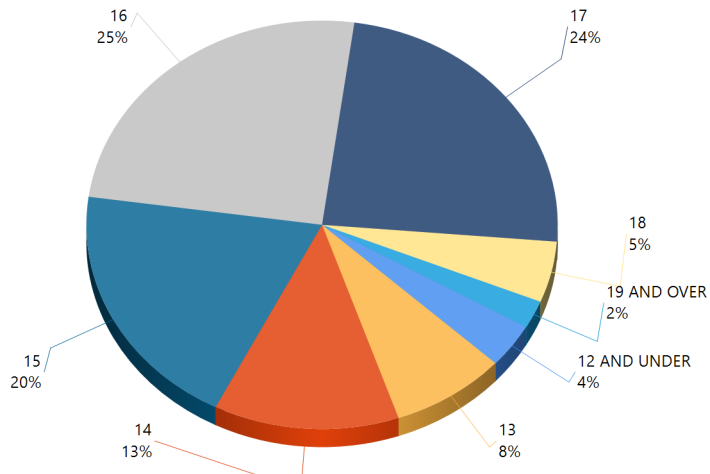
### By Ethnicity (%)



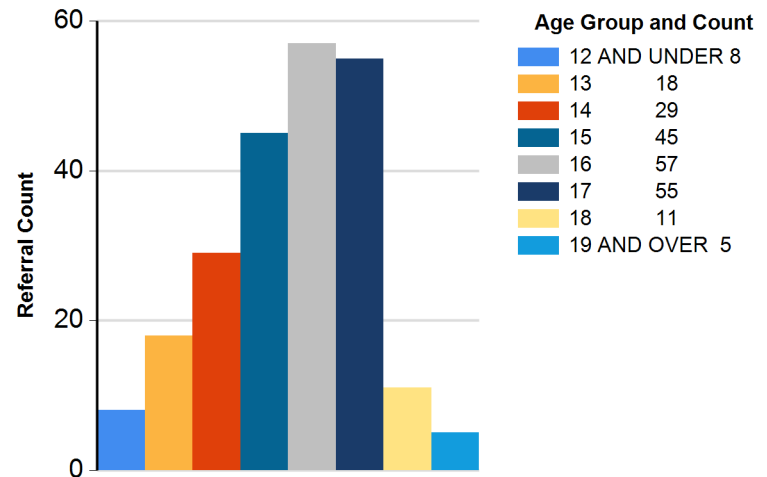
### By Ethnicity (Count)

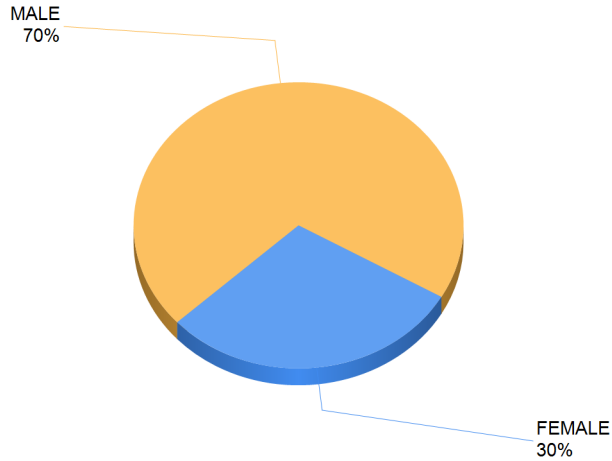

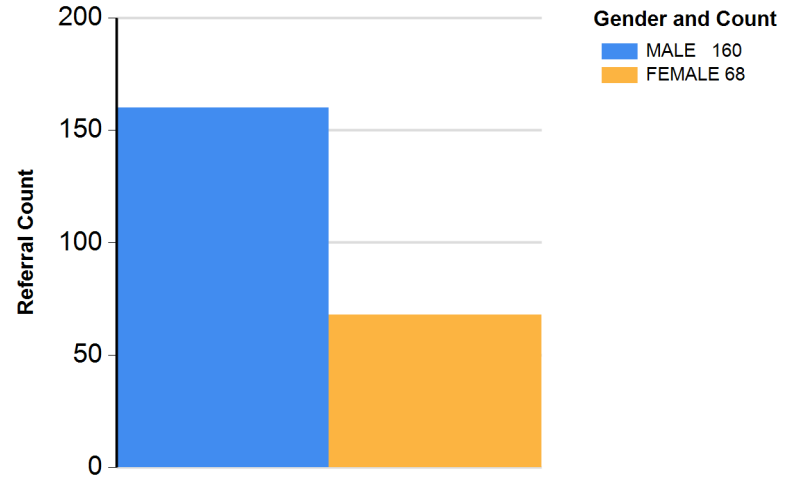

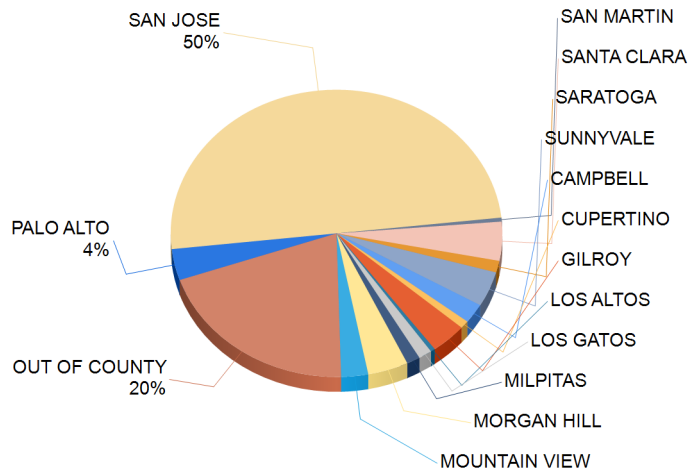
### By Gender (%)



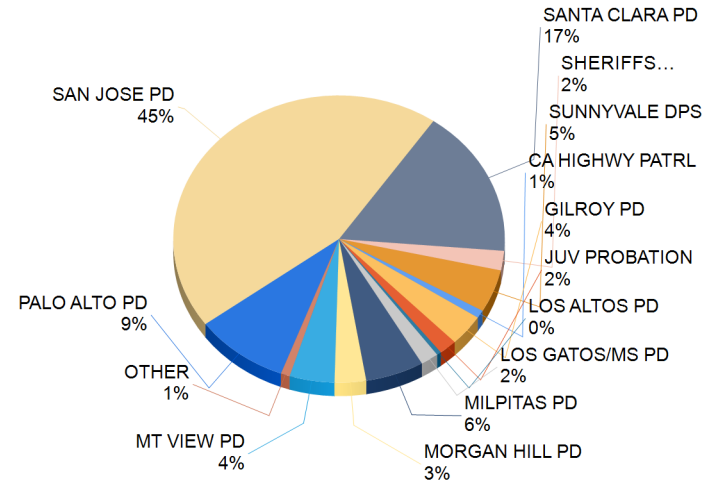

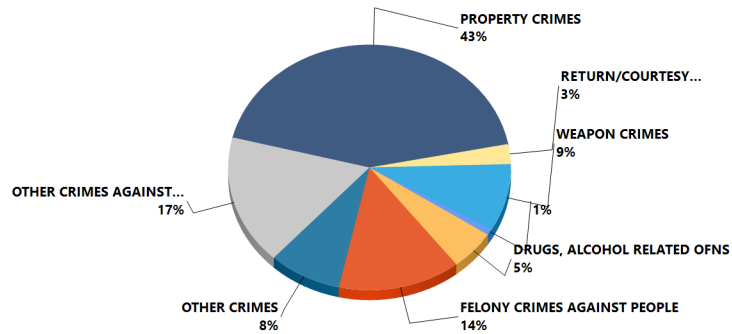
### By Referral Type (%)



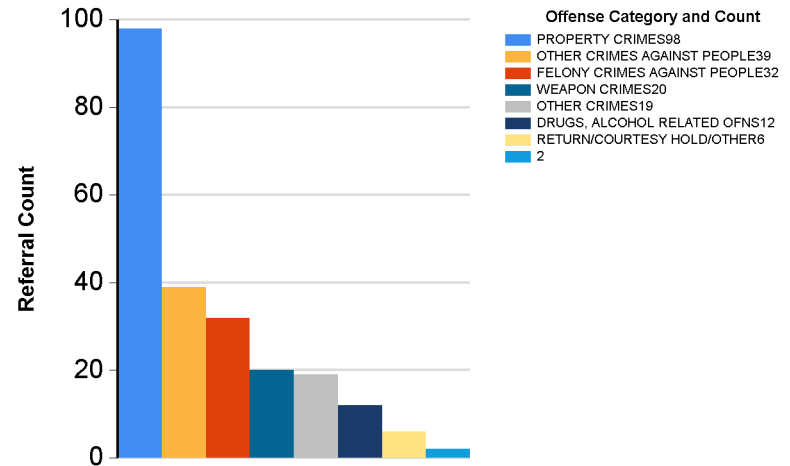
### By Referral Type (Count)

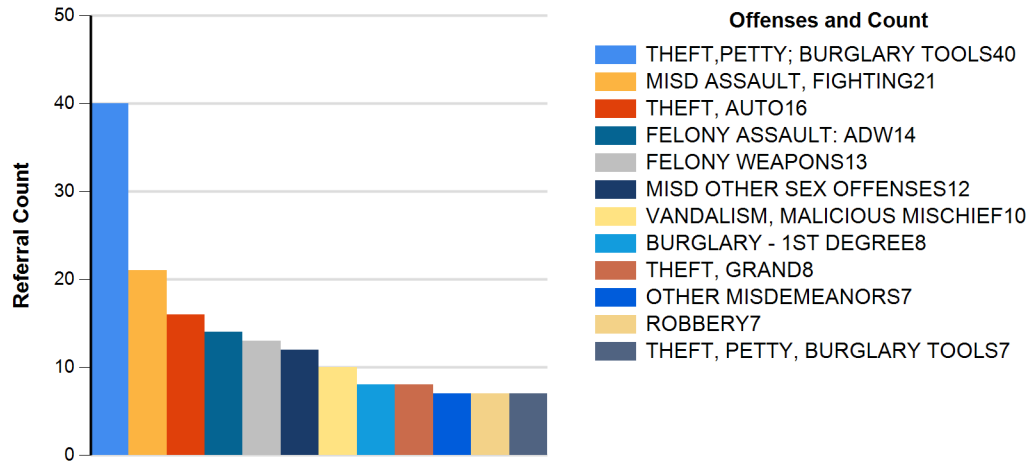

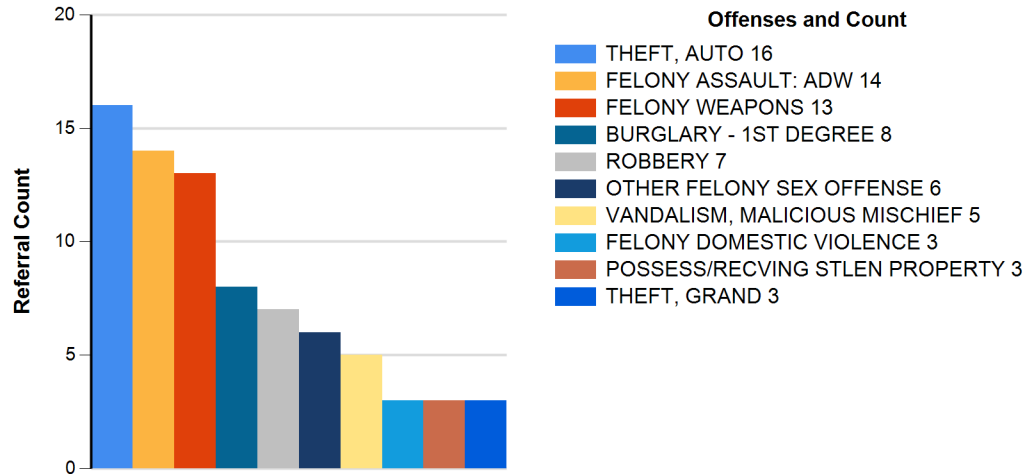
