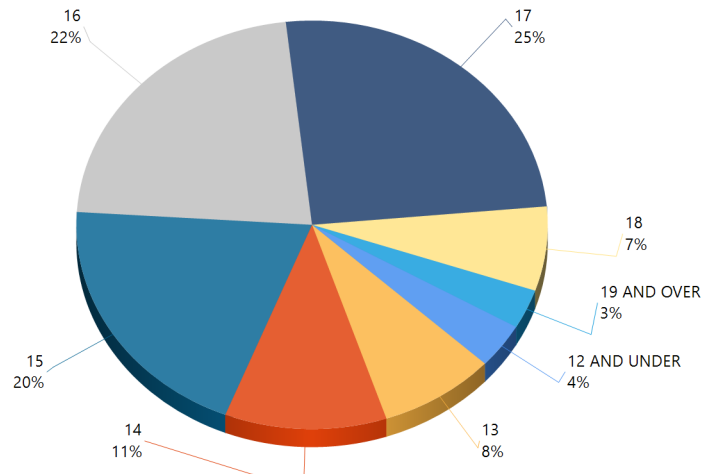
By Ethnicity (%)



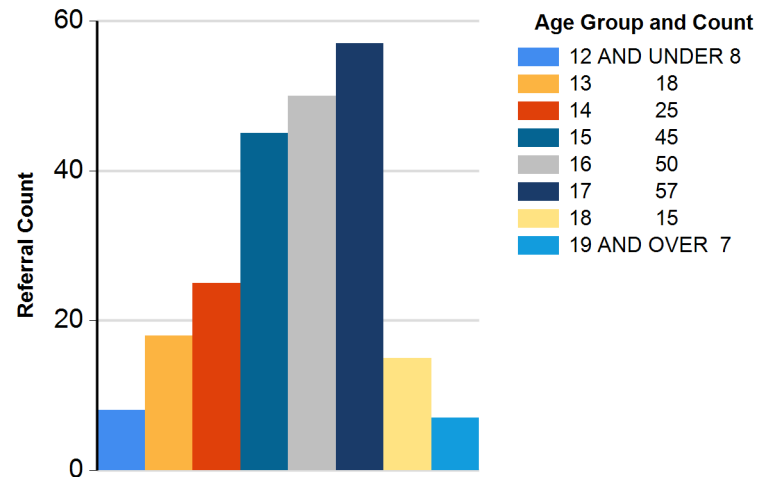
By Ethnicity (Count)

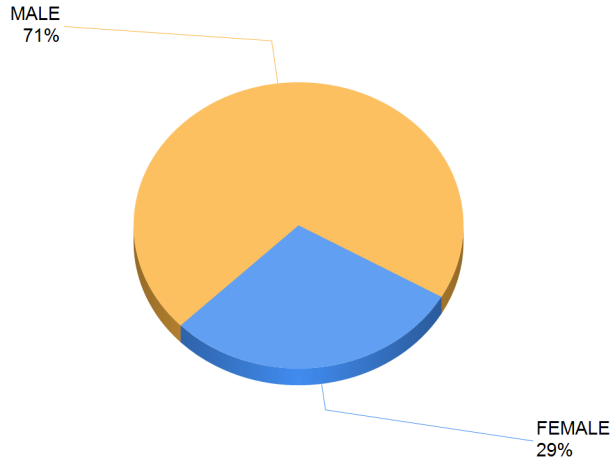

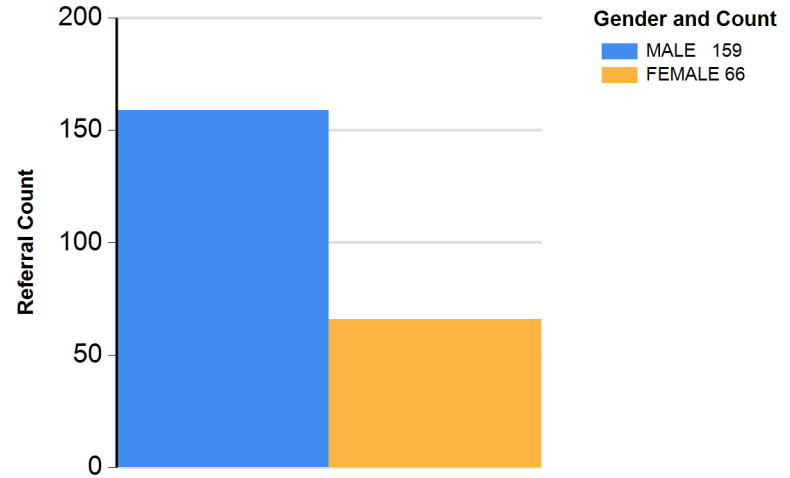

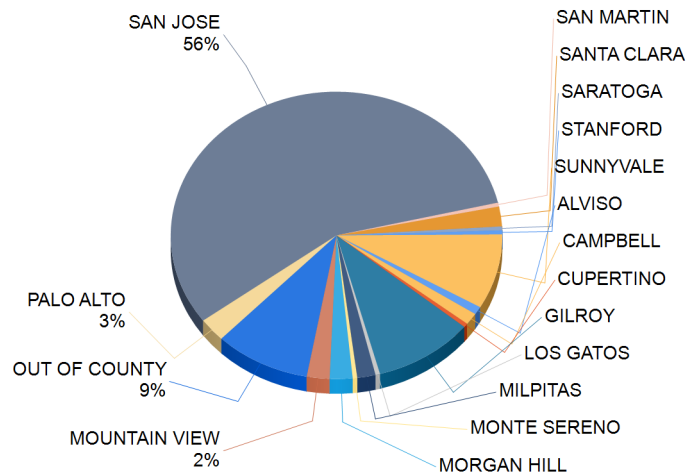
By Gender (%)



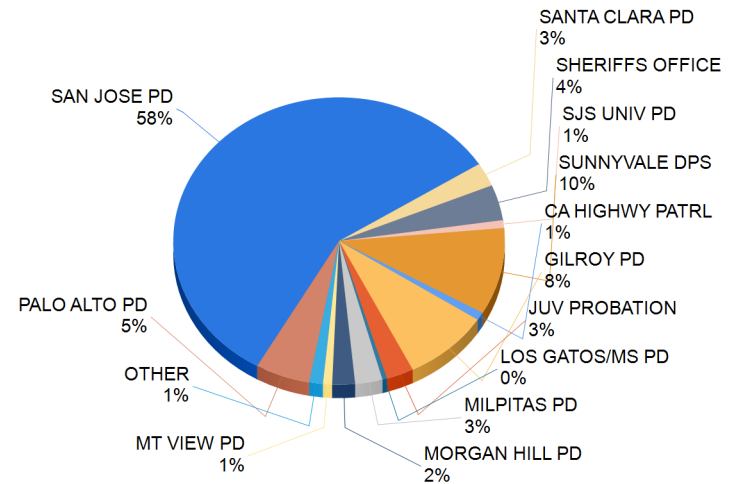

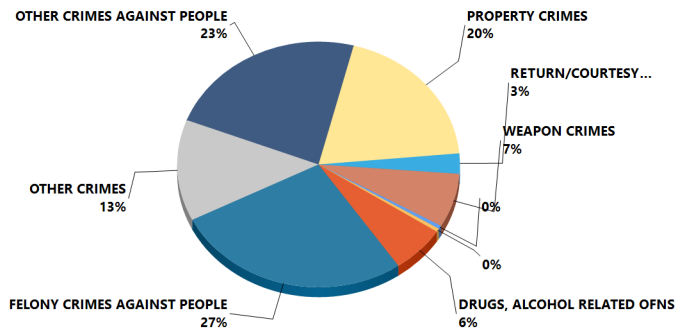
By Referral Type (%)



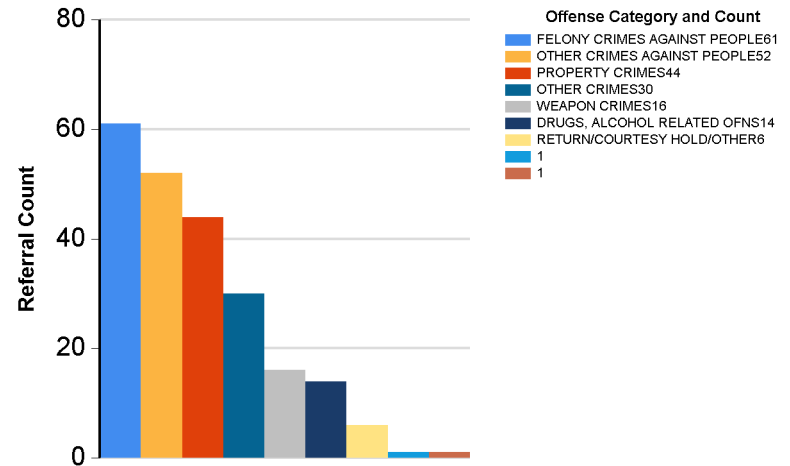

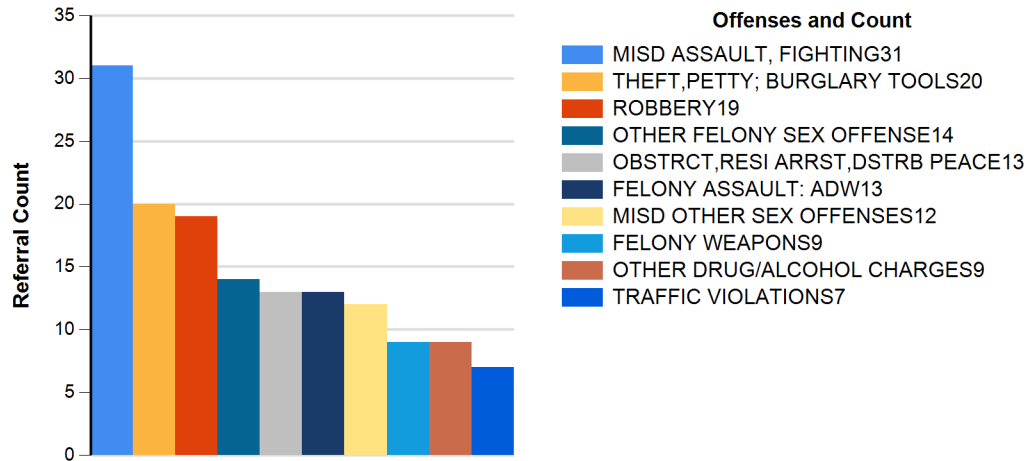

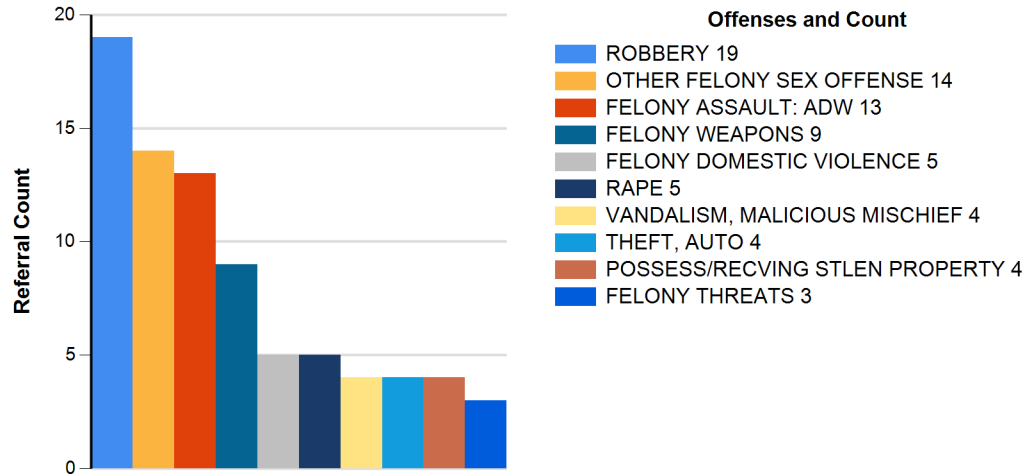
